This week's Mass readings:    Isaiah 6:1-8  
    Psalm 138:1-8  
    1 Corinthians 15:1-11  
    Luke 5:1-11

In Luke's Gospel lesson today we are told that Jesus came upon some fishermen who had spent a long night without catching any fish. Fishing was the way these men made money to take care of their families, so a night without catching anything would impact many people. When they decided to follow Jesus' suggestion that they try to catch fish one more time, they ended up with more fish than they had ever seen. At that moment these fishermen realized the power and might of Jesus and dropped everything to follow Him. Even the possibility of enough fish to take care of their families for many years was not as compelling as following Jesus who could provide for them much more than just physical comfort. There may be times when we doubt if Jesus is caring for us because we are suffering in some way and we may be tempted to turn away from Him. In these moments we need to remember all the times Jesus has provided for us and that He will always love and care for us.
