Loving God, as a parish community, nourished by your Word and Eucharist, we ask you to grant us wisdom, courage and generosity so that we might:

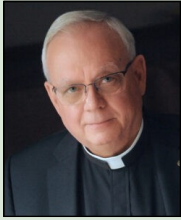
- welcome others without prejudice;

In the Gospel today, Jesus addressed this parable to those who were convinced of their own righteousness and despised everyone else. When our attitude toward others is one of despise and dismissal, we have rejected their dignity and worth. The Lord has called us to love God and our neighbor. Despising our neighbor is a strong indicator of our rejection of God. Notice that the one person in the Gospel is praising himself, not God. The tax collector on the other hand humbly asks for God's mercy.

The invitation and challenge that I offer to you and me is to search for and recognize where the Love of Jesus has touched our life or the lives of those around us. The more we recognize God's love for us, the more open we might be in evaluating whether we love others or where we fall short. May our desire for God's mercy open our hearts to his love and how we can share His love with those around us.

Next weekend, November 2nd is All Souls Day. We will be praying for all our beloved dead especially those who have died since last November.

Next weekend I will be installed as pastor here at St. Patrick and also at St. Angela. Since next Sunday is the last Sunday Mass at Saints Peter and Paul, I ask for your special prayer for them, and I ask you to be welcoming and supportive of our parishioners so that they know that they will be received warmly at our other Masses.

LUCK OF THE IRISH RAFFLE

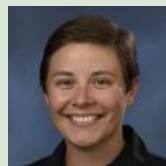
