Many of our struggles to forgive are found in the stumbles and fumbles we make as we find ourselves hurting the people we love most. In the very same awkward and difficult moment we can be both the aggrieved father, whose discipline



would be more than justified, and we can be the self-centered son, who seems to find it easy to hurt the ones who love him most. We can be either one of them or a complicated combination of both. Like the gospel father's encounter with the prodigal, we all have it within us, the grace to forgive and to be forgiven. We have within us

the love of God that empowers us to seek and offer forgiveness and to make right what our selfish imperfection has broken or shattered. It's what makes it possible for us to carry on. It is forgiveness, it is mercy, it is the love of God which makes us who we are. Blessings!!
