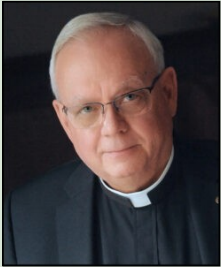

As We Journey Together, May Christ Light Our Way.

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

I was on retreat this past week at St. Mary Seminary in Cleveland. All our families were in my prayers!



Today the Scriptures invite us to realize our special and gifted relationship to the Father through Jesus. Jesus is especially encouraging us to trust him in the face of difficulties and adversity. Our faith is tested in difficult times and when problems seem to fill our life. It is at times like these that the psalmist response needs to be our refrain: "Lord, in your great love, answer me." I am always amazed and encouraged when I see the faith of people in the midst of problems and struggles. Its easy to be a faithful disciple in good times, but our quality of discipleship shines when its light shines forth in adversity.

Our special relationship echoes the faithfulness of Jeremiah in the first reading. Times of difficulty remind us of the sinfulness and shortcomings of life that need the saving grace of Jesus Christ. It is this salvation at work among us from Jesus that Matthew speaks about when he calls us to trust in him, find our strength in him, to have his saving grace at work in us today.

In the next few months, I will be asking people of the parish to consider their time and talents in ministry. I pray that we can renew and expand our outreach to the homebound and those in nursing homes. Also, I invite members of the parish to consider helping with bereavement ministry and helping families with funeral preparation.

On July 4, 2026, Bishop Bonnar will celebrate a special Mass at St. Columba Cathedral at 9:00 am. Please join the Bishop at Mass as we pray for our country. We will pray in thanksgiving for 250 years of our nation, and we will pray in supplication for the Lord's mercy and grace that we might be a people working for the freedom and peace of all people in the years to come!
